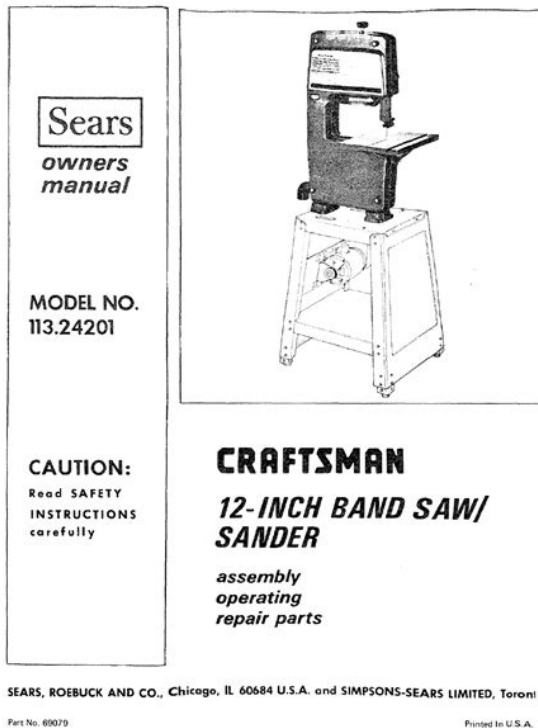

I also made some nice large picture frames. But I was younger and stupider then. To solve the problem with your missing bushing. Go to Harbor Freight. Buy 4 to six sets of these bushings and then stack them inside your molding cutter. Disclaimer. Using the molding cutter in either a table saw or radial arm saw is extremely dangerous.
